The chapter, *The One who Survived- Ada Blackjack*, is a story of a woman who goes on an expedition to an island in Northern Siberia and how she adjusts with the harsh weather and living conditions there.

1. Showcase the front page of a newspaper with a headline on Ada Blackjack after she returns from the expedition and write an **article** of 250 words on her stay there. Your camera isn't working, so make an appropriate **illustration** to add value to your article. Use an A4 size sheet and remember to make a border.

2. Unfortunately Lorne dies leaving Ada alone. As Ada, write three **diary entries** from that day of his death to the day leading up to the rescue. Each entry should be about 80-100 words focusing on the changing emotions. Use half an A4 sheet for each entry and make a diary cover also.

3. Just prior to going on a summer holiday, you started reading the story of Sinbad the Sailor and his different adventures. Inspired by his story, you plan to make a **survival kit** for yourself. Explain what items would be part of your kit and its importance. Also make a **daily schedule** for yourself- incase you get stranded on an island like him. Use two A4 sheets for this activity. Represent the information pictorially and you will have to explain the same.


### Activity 1

### A. Mind map of Adaptations

As you have studied adaptations are any behavioural or physical characteristics of an animal that help it to survive in its environment. Any or all of these types of adaptations play a critical role in the survival of an animal and animals have evolved their adaptations. This means a long period of slow change resulted in an animal's adaptation.

Pick up an example of an animal which has adapted to each type of the climate: cold climate, hot climate, and hot and wet climate; and create a mind map of their adaptations. An example has been given below for your reference.

Note: Activity is to be done on A4 sheets.



### b) Animals at a risk from climatic change

Climate change has thrown our beautifully balanced planet into chaos. The researchers found that the climatic chaos we've sowed may just be too intense. Some species seem to be adapting, yes, but they aren't doing so fast enough. As oceans and forests transform and ecosystems go into shock, perhaps a million species teeter on the edge of extinction.



Search the examples of animals which belong to cold climate, hot climate, and hot and wet climate; and are on the verge of extinction due to climatic changes. Research and document the reason(s) behind their extinction too.

Note: - Activity is to be done on A4 sheets.

- Paste/ draw the picture of the animals on the verge of extinction.

#### Activity 2: To construct a rain gauge.

Materials Needed: Empty plastic water bottle, cutter, ruler, adhesive tape.

Procedure:

1. Cut the empty plastic water bottle from the middle, take off the cap, insert it upside down and paste it using adhesive tape.

2. Paste a ruler on one side of the bottle using adhesive tape.

3. On a rainy day, place the rain gauge in the open and measure the rain poured daily over a week.

### **MATHEMATICS**

#### 1. Cyclones (Last ten years data): (Art Integrations)


On a A - 4 Sheet make big droplet of rain and in each droplet write the name of a cyclone that hit India in last ten years also write the windspeed at the time of landfall for each cyclone.



(Remember rain comes from cloud)

**2.** Collect the data of last five cyclones that hit the world: Write the speed of the wind at the time of landfall and the number of deaths due to that cyclone. Draw a double bar graph against each cyclone.

### 3. Sea Level Changes:



As global temperatures increase, water expands. This means that the volume of the world's oceans will steadily increase in time. This causes the sea level to increase. Also, some areas of the world are still changing after the enormous weight of the ice sheets from the last Ice Age have gone away. This causes land areas to rise, and so in those coastal areas, such as the East Coast of North America, sea levels are falling. A simple function that models the average sea level around the world is given by H(X) = 0.21X - 401.1

where X is the year (currently X=2021), and H is the sea level change since 1910 in centimeters.

On the basis of above equation solve the following problems:

Problem 1 - What was the change in sea level by (in cms)

- a) 1960?
- b) 1980?
- c) 2000 ?
- d) 2020 ?

Problem 2 - Compared to 2020, how much higher will it be in the year 2100 according to this model?
