More than just a visit, this programme transformed students into confident global citizens and proud ambassadors of their school, carrying lifelong friendships and unforgettable experiences beyond borders.





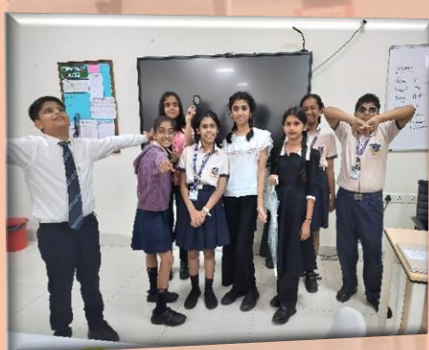
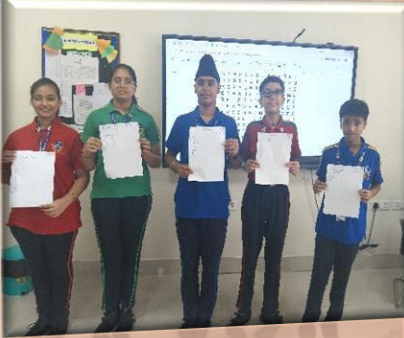


Book Week Celebrations

The celebration concluded on a joyful and inspiring note, leaving students motivated to explore the wonderful world of books and develop lifelong reading habits.



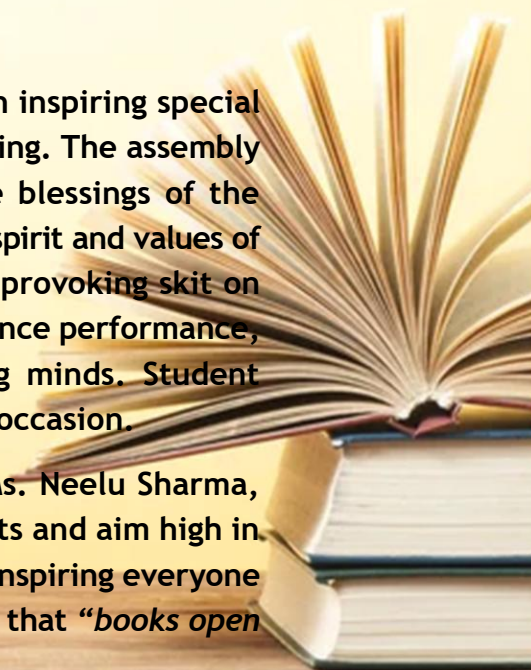

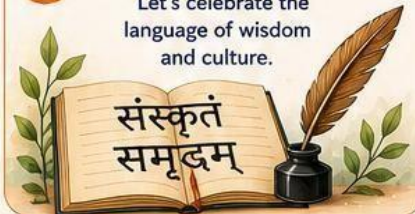
