

Things Required;


- Cartridge Sheet/ Pastel Sheet

Things required:


- A3 or A4 size paper

- On the ninth page make a bouquet for your grandparents using dry leaves and dry petals.
- On the last page draw your favorite cartoon character.



Sensorial Activity (Salt Painting)

Sensory activities facilitate exploration and naturally encourage children to use scientific process while they play, create, investigate and explore. This activity will cater to skin sensation. (Touch and Feel).

Things required:

- Thick A4 sheet (any light color)
- Pencils, erasers
- Table salt
- Liquid water colors
- Paint brushes / droppers
- Squeeze bottle of glue

Directions:

- Draw any flower on the sheet.
- Put glue on the outline of the flower.
- Put table salt on it.
- Dip your paint brush into liquid water color then gently paint the salt.

Let it dry thoroughly.

Shapes Puzzle

• Find 5 things which are in the shape of a circle, triangle and square.

Learning Objectives:

The shape puzzle activity using cut out of carton, colors and marker is a great introduction to basic mathematics and Stem type activities. It is amazing to find out how many shapes you can find in your own environment. Children are always looking at shapes and once you start pointing them out, children become fascinated by them. This simple shape activity is a great example of where education and fun are mashed together!

Things required:

- Carton cut outs
- Color


- Color brushes
- Bold Marker

Directions: Make a Circle, Square and Triangle by following the given instruction.

• Make Circle, Square, and Triangle on different carton cutouts.

- Color these shape, each with a different color.
- Cut each carton cut outs into nine small square pieces.
- Draw a border using a black marker for all 27 squares.
- Now join the pieces together to make different shapes.

Activities that teach young children about fast and slow can also connect content areas such as science, language and even the creative arts as the children learn about this pair of opposites.

Things required:

- A3 / A4 size sheet
- Pictures of different things that move slow and fast
- Glue




Direction:
