These activities not only made learning enjoyable but also encouraged **curiosity**, **teamwork**, and **creativity** among the students.



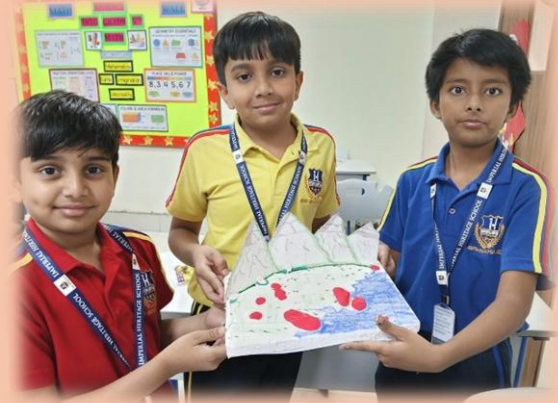
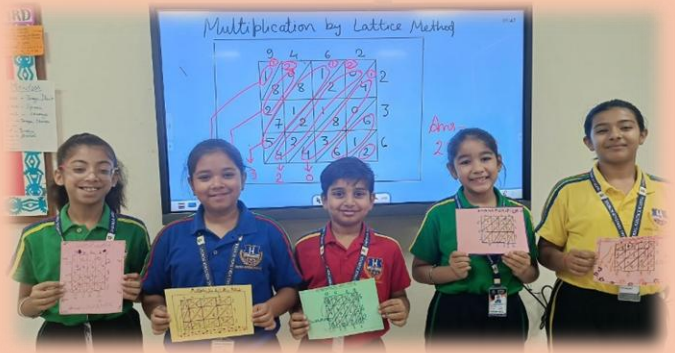

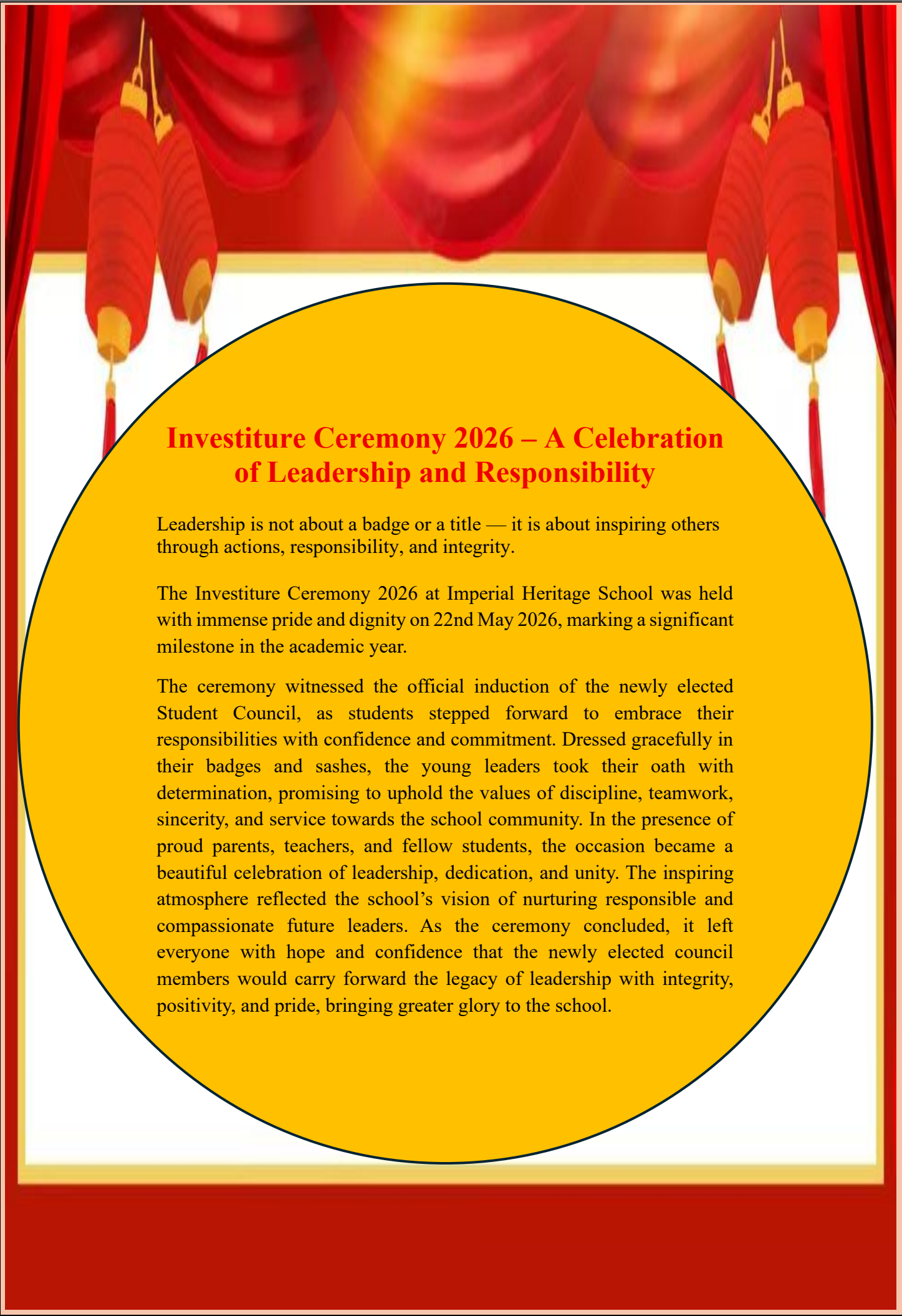

On 20th May 2026, students of Grades III to V enjoyed *The Super Mario Bros. Movie*, a fun-filled and colourful adventure.

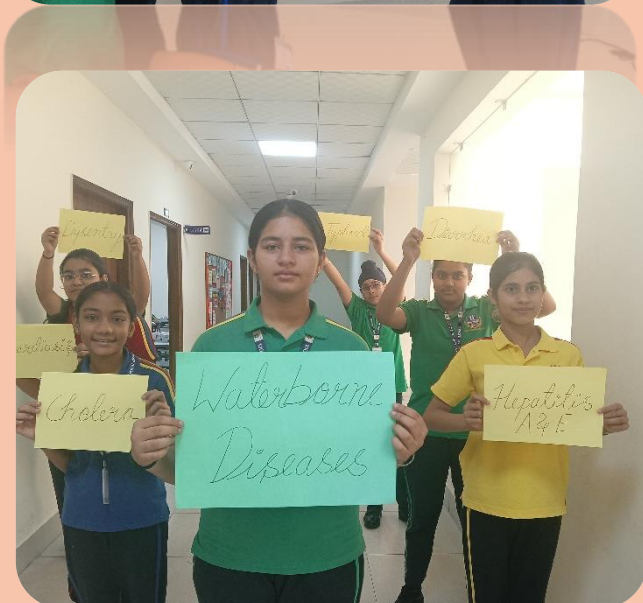
Students relished the movies along with snacks, making the outing joyful and memorable for all.

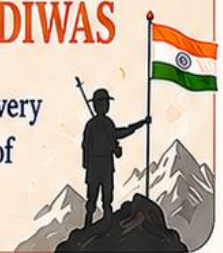
