COLOUR DAYS

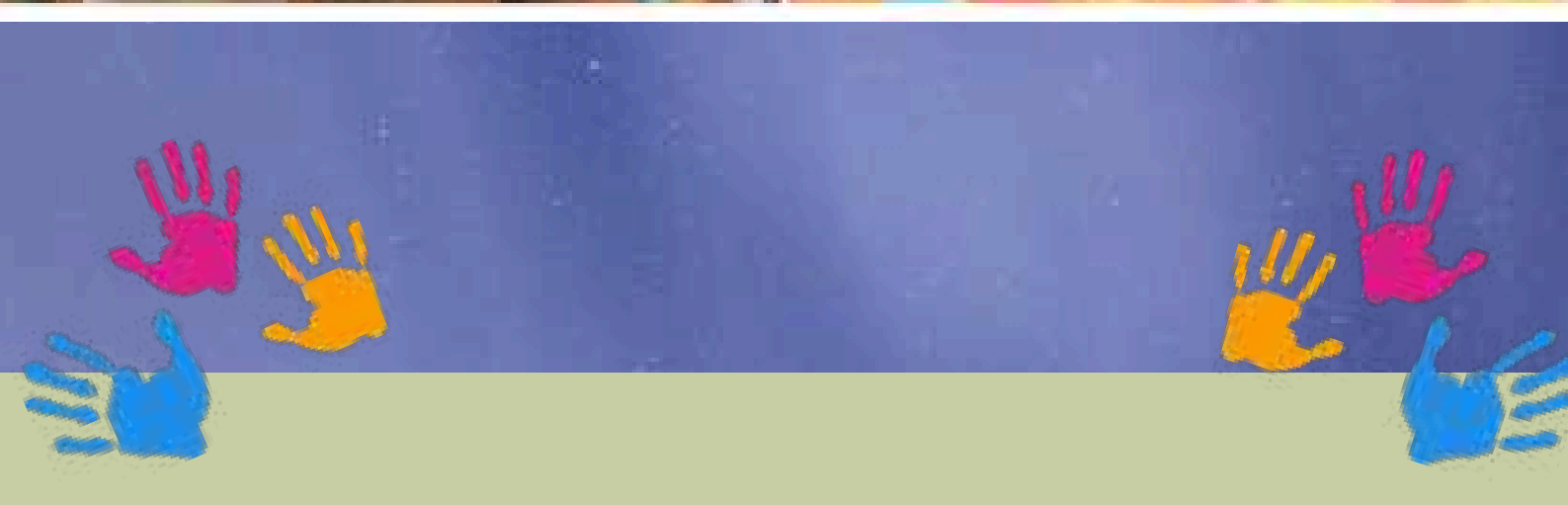

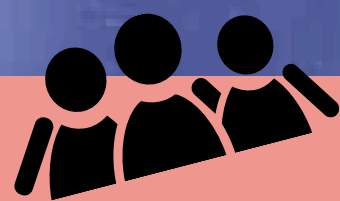
SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

Exploring Cultures, Celebrating Unity: A Glimpse into Our School Mornings.

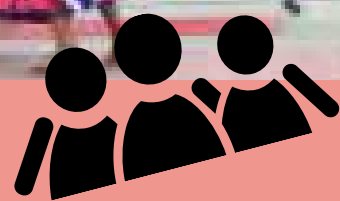

ROBOTICS

With a deep commitment to fostering innovation and critical thinking skills among students, the Robotics Lab serves as an interactive hub for transformative education, emphasizing hands-on learning through a comprehensive S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) curriculum. It stands as a beacon of innovation and experiential learning, empowering students to become well-rounded individuals capable of tackling real-world challenges with creativity and proficiency. The integration of S.T.E.A.M. education and the Project-Based Learning approach ensures that students are not just learning concepts but are actively engaging with them, paving the way for a future generation of adept and innovative thinkers.

Each project outcome not only demonstrates technical prowess but also highlights the students' ability to collaborate, innovate, and present their prototypes or ideas effectively. For example,

In grade 1, students constructed a Vegetable piano. By combining everyday vegetables with technology to create music, kids learn how to integrate art and technology, fostering an appreciation for interdisciplinary approaches to creativity and innovation.

This was followed by grade 2, where they worked on Green Routing. In this project, learners assisted a robot (bee bot) in finding the shortest route to reach a desired destination, thereby enhancing their understanding of sequencing, spatial awareness, and logical thinking.

Moving up to grade 3, students implemented the Seasonal saver project, wherein they designed a seasonal kit consisting of useful tools to help street children survive in extreme conditions. One of the tools included a solar-powered fan.

In grade 4, they designed a Home security system, developing a safety alarm system equipped with PIR motion sensors and flame sensors to ensure secure and protected living environments.

Grade 5 focused on developing an Oil spill Cleaner that efficiently cleaned spilled oil in oceans using microbit technology.

Progressing further, grade 6 students crafted Tool Ninja, creating a tool manager to assist workers in efficiently managing critical tools during tasks.

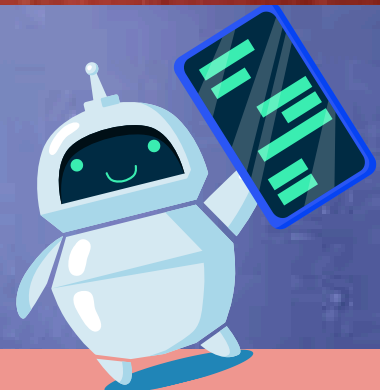
In grade 7, students explored Bio bots, constructing nature-inspired robots to learn about the biomechanics of various organisms.

Grade 8 saw the creation of a Mood light, where learners built a lighting system that adjusted according to the user's mood using ESP8266 and RGB LED technology.

In grade 9, students engineered a Remote health monitoring system to enable doctors to remotely monitor vital health parameters of people living in remote areas.

Finally, in grade 10, students invented a Smart Switch, a virtual switch utilizing Internet of Things technology to control remote devices and appliances.

Through all these projects, the learners have not only honed their technical skills but have also cultivated a deep sense of innovation, collaboration, and problem-solving, preparing them to excel in a rapidly evolving world.

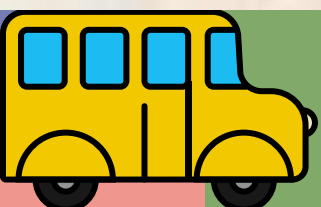

By stepping outside the confines of the classroom, students had the opportunity to enhance their social interactions, forging bonds with their peers and teachers in a relaxed and stimulating environment.

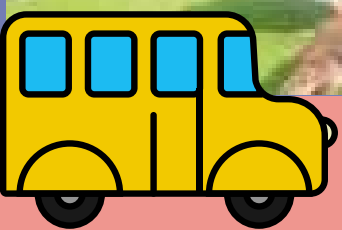

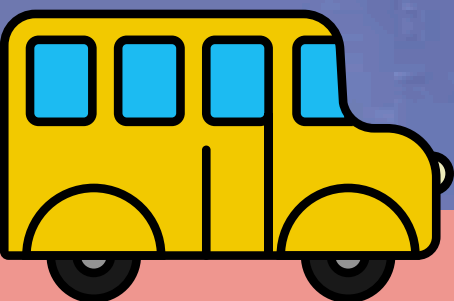

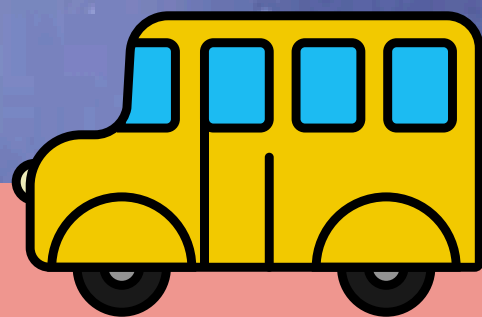












GRADUATION DAY
