From Principal's Desk:

I feel parenting is the greatest challenge in today's time.

As parents we find it difficult to set limits for our young kids. Stress at one point of time was unheard of among kids. Now a day's, even a five-year-old can talk about it.

It is observed that kids, who are temperamentally fun loving, easy going and helping suddenly start losing patience. They tend to do things that make no sense. They insist on having things which someone else has or indulge in squabbling.

All these are warning signals for the parents. During this time, we parents need to play a very positive role. We need to help them relieve the stress and also regain their innate joy, confidence and happiness.

For this first we ourselves need to be calm. A child who is already upset will not open up if we are also agitated. Few things that need to be done are:

LISTEN – Make eye contact with the child and ask her/him why she/he is yelling, shouting or wants a particular thing. Remember to stay calm.

LIMIT – Next is to limit the unwanted behavior. If the child is yelling and does not stop, best thing to do is to pick the child and take her/him in the other room. If she/he wants to have unreasonable number of chocolates then pick up the child in your lap, take her/him away from the chocolates and tell 'you can have it later'. No punishment, no harshness or lectures will work as the child is not in the frame of mind to listen. What works is **BEING GENTLE BUT FIRM.**

LOVE – It is important to create an emotionally safe environment at home so that our kids know that they can fall back on us at the time of distress.

COMMUNITY HELPERS



Reading is a stress buster which is very effective if you have a good book. Try these tips to cultivate a lifelong reading habit.


SET TIMES: You should have a set time every day when you will read for at least 5-10 minutes. That's a great start by itself for a reader.
