Dear Parents,

Welcome October, where the weather is perfect, as there is a smooth transition from warm to cool weather. October also marks the beginning of the festive season and rings in laughter and joy.

Students of Grade I had an enjoyable September as they learnt many concepts. In Numeracy, they enjoyed learning about shapes and differentiating solid and flat shapes. They engaged in an activity of making 3D shapes using sticks and clay dough, getting a better understanding of 2D and 3D shapes. In EVS the concept of Air and water and its properties was explained through experiments. Students understood that air gives shape as they blew balloons in the class and released the air to deflate it. They also did a group activity of drying one painting under the fan and letting the other one dry in the corridor and understood that air helped the painting to dry faster. In Literacy, the concept of pronouns was introduced through a video, where students enjoyed listening to the story and learning about pronouns through it. The value for the month of September was Family where children spoke a few lines about why they love their family, using a family tree as a prop. Through this activity they learned that family is the key to achieving greater heights in life.

The month of August ended with National Sports Day, commemorating the birth anniversary of hockey legend Major Dhyan Chand Singh. *Faster, Higher, Stronger* is the sole motive of any sports event and students celebrated this day by enthusiastically participating in fun races. Rakshabandhan, the festival of the special bond between a brother and a sister, was also celebrated at the end of the month where students made rakhis for their special one at home.

As the common adage goes, the future of a country lies in the hands of its children and teachers, by whom they are shaped to become future leaders. The month of September played host to Teachers' Day and students expressed their gratitude and respect to their teachers by gifting them flowers and handmade cards. This day is celebrated as Teachers Day to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan- a renowned scholar and a great teacher. Celebrating Janamashthami, students enthusiastically celebrated the birthday of Lord Krishna by making a feather that adorns Lord Krishna's crown.

Hindi Diwas was celebrated on 14th September, where students did an activity on different maatras, learning the importance of our National language. Students were amazed to learn about the 7 Wonders of the World and also made a beautiful scrapbook while celebrating World Tourism Day. First Aid Day was also celebrated in the school and the school nurse educated the students on the importance of first aid in case of any medical emergency around them.
