3. General Information

- School timing is 8.00 am – 2:30 pm. The school gate will be closed at 8.05 am. No entry will be allowed post that.
- Students must carry the almanac to school daily.
- Parents should check the almanac and ERP app regularly for any information.
- Students should be in the proper school uniform. Kindly use only black rubber bands, clips, or hair bands. Black shoes are to be worn every day.
- Label your child's belongings like lunch box, water bottle, bag, shoes, etc.
- Students must wear ID cards daily.
- Leave application must be submitted to the class teacher, one day prior in the case of pre-planned leave. In case of illness, a medical certificate must be submitted within three days of rejoining school.
