Play is our brain's favourite way of learning. Students did a lot of hands-on activities in different subjects to understand various concepts which were introduced to them. **In English** to strengthen students' understanding of adjectives, a hands-on and engaging activity was conducted in the classroom. The aim was to help students identify nouns around them and describe them using suitable describing words. The activity began with students drawing simple nouns—such as an apple and their family members—and using adjectives to describe their drawings. This helped them relate adjectives to real and familiar objects. Next, students brought their favourite toys from home and described them using different adjectives, encouraging careful observation and expressive language. In the final stage, students used clay to create their own toys and objects. After crafting, they described their creations using a variety of adjectives. This multi-step activity allowed students to explore adjectives creatively, build vocabulary, and use descriptive language confidently in context.

In **E.V.S** chapter- 'Our Shelter' students first created **miniature house models** using recycled materials such as cardboard, sticks, and clay. They then moved on to visualizing the future by drawing **sustainable shelters of tomorrow**. Their sketches featured innovative ideas like solar panels, rainwater harvesting systems, green rooftops, and other earth-friendly elements—showcasing a deep understanding of how homes can be kinder to the planet. In the chapter on Mapping, they learned about maps and directions through hands-on activities. Students first created their own imaginative **Treasure map and the map of their classrooms**, adding creative landmarks, routes, and unique features that brought their ideas to life. They then crafted **their own compasses**, helping them understand directions in a fun and interactive way. This simple yet engaging activity strengthened their spatial awareness and curiosity about the world around them.

In **Mathematics** the chapter on Capacity, students conducted experiments to determine which jar could hold the most, enhancing their understanding of volume and measurement.

As part of **Janjatiya Diwas**, teachers conducted classroom discussions on the rich heritage of local tribal communities. Students learned about traditional food, cultural diversity, values, and unique tribal traditions. The activity helped them appreciate indigenous cultures and understand the importance of preserving this vibrant heritage.

The value of the month was Honesty and students shared incidents where they were honest and the repercussions it had. Mixed with laughter, they agreed that *honesty is the best policy* in life.

3. General Information
