**Run For Unity** - On 28th October 2024, Imperial Heritage School, proudly hosted the CBSE Unity Run, an inspiring event organized in honour of the upcoming National Unity Day on 31st October. The initiative, aimed at fostering unity and harmony among young minds, saw enthusiastic participation from students, staff, and faculty. Participants wore ‘Run for Unity’ badges and carried banners promoting peace, diversity, and mutual respect as they jogged through the school premises, embodying the true spirit of togetherness and national pride.

**World Immunization Day - Preparing Vaccine Card** - Observed globally on 10th November, **World Immunization Day** reminds us of the vital role vaccines play in building a healthier and safer future for everyone. To deepen students’ understanding of preventive healthcare, students participated in an activity wherein they designed an Immunization (Vaccine) Card highlighting Vaccine Name, Disease Prevented, and Age or Schedule. This engaging activity aims to raise awareness about the importance of immunization and encourage students to value the role of vaccines in maintaining community health.

**Birsa Munda’s Birth Anniversary** - As part of our efforts to instill pride in our nation’s leadership and honor India’s rich tribal heritage CBSE has announced Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas, the students prepared a colourful and informative poster on Birsa Munda and presented it in class. The presentation was based on the research they did on the legacy of Birsa Munda, the great tribal leader and freedom fighter who fought the British with primitive weapons but great courage.

**Road Safety Workshop:** In collaboration with the Gurugram Police, IHS organized an engaging Road Safety Programme to create awareness among students. Officers interacted with learners, demonstrating safe road practices, traffic rules, and the importance of responsible behaviour. Through videos, demonstrations, and discussions, students learned essential safety measures. The session strengthened awareness and encouraged children to become responsible and alert road users.

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**Subject Enrichment Activities: In Science**, students went on a nature walk, collecting various leaf samples with unique venation patterns! They explored the outdoors, observing the beauty of nature and collecting specimens. They then created a beautiful herbarium, documenting each plant's details and leaf characteristics. They also participated in the fascinating processes of **evaporation, condensation, filtration, and distillation** through practical experiments.
