On the birth anniversary of the great tribal leader and freedom fighter **Birsa Munda** on 14th November, our school proudly celebrated his legacy of courage, equality, and empowerment. To honour his contributions and promote awareness of India's rich tribal heritage, students across grades participated in engaging, creative activities. Grades IX explored various government schemes supporting tribal development, connecting them to Birsa Munda's ideals of justice and empowerment. This activity not only deepened students' understanding of India's cultural diversity but also nurtured creativity, empathy, and pride in our nation's rich heritage, political system, and social diversity.

Subject Based Activities:

Physics



📣 IHS News –
