Greetings!

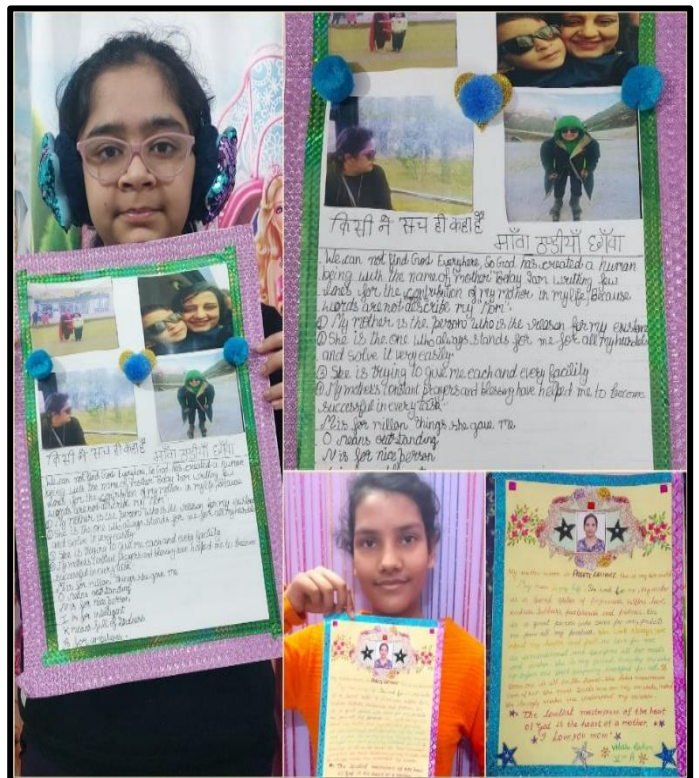
Let’s Welcome February and March, the months of lasting changes. “In February and March, there is everything to hope for and nothing to regret.”

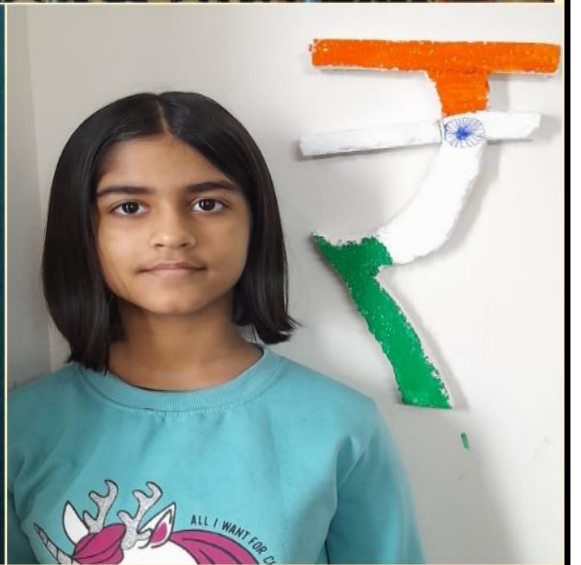

#### **For students opting for online classes:**
