The month of December proved to be a month full of excitement and learning new concepts. The concept of measurement was introduced, where children learnt about the non-standard units like cubit, hand span, foot span and stride. They enjoyed measuring the size of their rooms, tables etc. The topic of 'Sky' was introduced through a magic painting. They drew day and night sky in their notebooks and later learnt how day and night happen. We taught them about the Solar System as well. Now, students are able to identify the planets and determine the position of the planets from the sun. The students enjoyed the story of 'Means of transport'. A class competition was conducted on the same topic to reinforce the concept. All students made very creative 3D models of different modes of transport. The best part of this competition was that they used waste material like old boxes of soaps, matchsticks etc. They had created the model of different types of houses with the help of clay for learning the topic 'Houses we live in'. The concept of is, am and are and has/have was also taught to them.

During the month, we celebrated 'World Mountain Day', where as a home activity, children created beautiful scenery using clay, artificial plants, sand etc. Children learnt about different types of crops during 'Kisan Diwas' and created a collage differentiating cereals, pulses, vegetables and fruits. On National Mathematics they did multiplication in a fun way. To evoke feelings of nationalism and patriotism in children 'Vijay Diwas' was celebrated. Children created a colourful poster to show respect towards our brave soldiers. Grade IVB presented a wonderful assembly on Christmas through which children spread positivity everywhere and a cute Rudolf the Reindeer was made using handprint technique. Experiment nurtures intellectual curiosity, helping children acquire new ways of asking questions and understanding the world, with this objective Science Day was celebrated where children did an experiment on how sound travels. It was a fun learning and teaching experience for the students and for the teachers.



3. General Information

For students opting for online classes:

- -Parents should read all messages sent on the broadcast group.
- -Parents should be aware of the timetable of their ward, including extra classes.
- -Please ensure that your ward is well rested and has eaten breakfast before the session starts.
- -All students must join their classes on time and avoid any distractions around them.
- -All students to be ready with their textbooks, notebooks and stationery items.
- -Parents to ensure that sitting posture of their ward is correct to avoid backache.
- -Please ensure that the students are well turned out, preferably in school uniform.
- -Please ensure that the background is neat and tidy.
- -Students to be on mute until prompted otherwise by the teacher.
- -Any misbehaviour or attempt to disrupt the class will invite disciplinary action.
- -Parents should ensure that their ward has the video and audio on at all times during the classes.
- -Parents should check the internet connection on a daily basis to ensure that their ward doesn't miss classes.
- -In case a student is missing classes for the day, the parent must call the class teacher or send an e-mail. A message will not be accepted. -Parents should ensure that their ward is ready for class-bathed, had breakfast, with books for the day.
- -Parents should check the ERP for homework and other circulars uploaded.
- -Parents should encourage their ward to participate in all class activities and competitions.
- -Parents should ensure that all written assignments are completed on time and emailed to the subject teacher.
- -All students to log out as soon as the teacher dismisses the class.

For students opting for offline classes:

- -School timings are from 8:30 am to 2:30pm. Kindly adhere to the time. Students arriving later than 8:30am will not be allowed entry into the school.
- -Students to carry their old ID Card to school every day along with Parent Consent Form.
- -Students to wear mask at all times.
- -Students to carry their own sanitizer, lunch box, water bottle, books and stationery. No sharing of any item among students is allowed.
- -Handshaking, touching or hugging friends is not allowed.

Additional information:

- -Parents wishing to opt for offline classes from online classes for their wards will need to send a mail at info@imperialheritageschool.com. The school will then send a consent form which needs to be filled by the parents. The students have to carry duly filled consent form along with photocopies of vaccination certificates of family members on the first day of school.
