As monsoon sets in, it brings in a change in one's mood- optimism, new growth, cheerfulness are the various dispositions that one sees around. In the month of July, teachers focused on reconnecting and assessing the students after the summer break.

In the month of July **IHS** focused on **Experiential learning**. For physical, emotional and psychological development of a student, balance between academics and co-curricular activities is important. To make academics more interesting, various subject enrichment activities were done in the classroom and laboratories.

An activity of Travelogue in **English** was done with reference to the chapter – 'We are not afraid to Die if we can all be together'. The students of Grade XI shared their travel experiences wherein they faced certain difficulties or challenges and how they dealt with the situations.

Flip learning was done in the Chemistry with especial emphasis on Periodic table.Students explained the trends in physical and chemical properties within the group and period. In order to know more about elements **Quiz** was organised. Salt analysis was also done by students in the laboratory.

In **Physics** the students had done experiments of measuring instruments like Vernier callipers, Screw gauge and Spherometer in the laboratory.

Interactive visual learning of anatomy and physiology of the Human Respiratory System, mechanism of breathing and its regulation happened through physical models and videos in the **Biology** class.

Activity on **Sense Modalities was done in Psychology class.**-While studying the functional limitations of sense organs, for optimal understanding of the concept of Absolute Limen and Difference Limen, the students were actively engaged in hands-on demonstration.Students could comprehend that understanding of sensations is not possible without understanding the AL and DL of different types of stimuli.

As the school had celebrated **'Book Week'** a debate was conducted on the topic **''Hard Resources vs E-Resources''** wherein the students participated whole heartedly and shared their viewpoints. It was an enriching session for both the teams.

Values are an integral part of the curriculum at Imperial Heritage School .The value of the month was *Courage* and students have participated in discussion on the same. They shared their thoughts on how one should show courage to bring positive change in our society.

3. General Information
