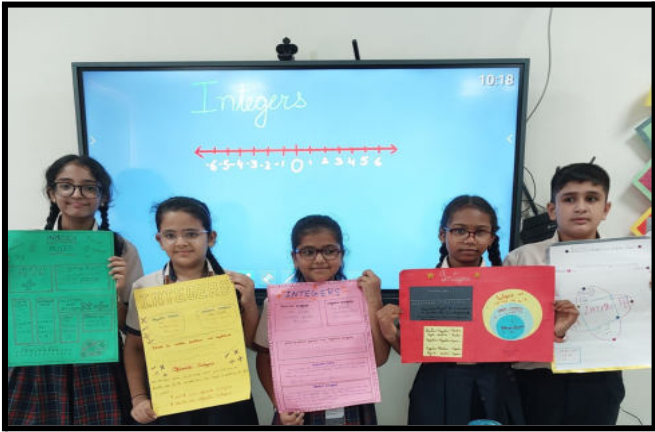

3. General Information
