Students had great fun on the last day before the Summer Vacation as they had a party in the class during lunch break, in a way learning the social skill of caring and sharing.

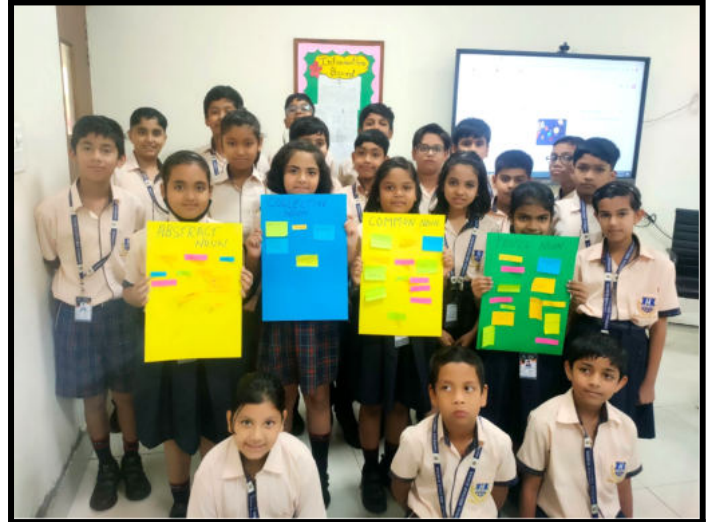
We are happy to announce the result of the Inter House Competition- Best Out of Waste.

## 3. General Information
