Inter House Competition was organized for the students wherein Grade IX participated in a heated Debate on Impact of Science and Technology on the Environment. Students of Grade IX participated in Umanita 2023-24 and SQCC 2023 organized by Ambience Public School, Gurugram and Raman Munjal Vidya Mandir respectively. Students participated in different segments of the fest such as Nukkad Natak, Conference: Symbiosis, Case study presentation etc.

International Exchange programs are meant to introduce fellow members of different communities to one another and to help them learn about International Youth Connections, Meeting- Global Citizens Community was held on 13th May, 2023 at 6:30pm. During this mesmerizing session, IHS student ambassador Devansh Nehra graced the evening by playing the tabla.

Along with the academic rigor, students got an opportunity to participate in activities for special days like **Jallianwala Bagh Massacre** where they designed a T- Shirt/ Handkerchief depicting the various events

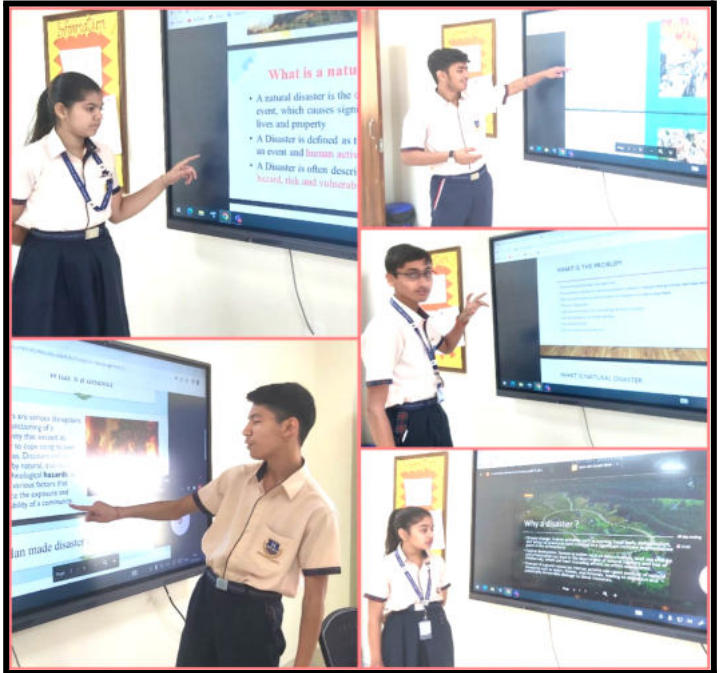

3. General Information
