The new session started with enthusiasm and vigor as the children entered school on the first day, brimming with curiosity and excitement. Settling into the new environment, meeting their peers and interacting with their teachers took a few days and the teachers did everything to make sure that the young ones didn't miss the comfort of their home. The children enjoyed the first day activity that helped them to be at ease and the end of the day saw smiling faces returning home.

On the academic front, students were introduced to cursive writing. Before commencing, they did fine motor exercises of stretching their fingers and rotating their wrists and writing on sand paper to improve their grip of the pencil. In *Numeracy* they were introduced to tens and ones. The theme in *EVS* was Me and Myself and the students learnt how to introduce themselves. They also learnt about the Five Sense Organs and students made five senses paper bag puppet. Show and Tell (Elements of Environment) Intra Class Competition was organized for KG students.

Green Colour Day was celebrated in school where the students were able to identify green items around themselves. They also engaged in a Show and Tell on a green object that they had got from home and leaf headband craft was made in the class. Environment Week was celebrated in school and the students participated in a series of act-3D paper bag activity, sorting of dry waste and wet waste (Nature Walk). For Earth Day they learnt about Save Trees, Save Water and Use of dustbins. Mothers Day was the highlight of the month and mothers enjoyed making crafts from Best Out Of Waste and the mothers were dressed up representing a state (Parent Involvement Activity). Students made Necklace with pasta and gave a wonderful token to mothers.
