Students commemorated the birth of a free nation after the relentless efforts of freedom fighters and revolutionaries against oppressive British rule.

Students of Grade XI presented a 'Special assembly' on the 14th to mark the 77th Independence Day, which gave an insight into our struggle for Independence while also showcasing Mahatma Gandhi's ideology of non-violence through a skit. They also presented a soul-stirring medley of patriotic songs, followed by a foot tapping dance.

The annual interschool competition, **Maadhyam**, was held with great enthusiasm on the school campus in August. More than 25 schools participated in various competitions highlighting the theme of Over the Ages - Past, Present, and Future. The students enjoyed a lovely Saturday in the company of their friends, showcasing their understanding of the theme.

As a part of CBSE activities, our students took part in 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign, under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to encourage them to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark the glory of India's Independence.

The 2nd CBSE Expression Series for the academic session 2023-24 was organized on the theme 'G-20: India's Vision For A Harmonious World' wherein the students wrote a poem on 'India's Road Map to Renewable Energy.

In commemoration of the 3rd Anniversary of NEP-2020, a CBSE activity, - One Child, One Plant, was conducted in the school premises, wherein the students planted saplings with a lot of zeal.

Our heritage provides clues to our past and how our society has evolved. It helps to examine our history and traditions and enables us to develop an awareness of ourselves. Team IHS conducted well planned activities and competitions during 'Heritage Week' and inculcated the value of patriotism. With the objective of celebrating and appreciating the history and vast cultural heritage of our country an Inter house Competition was conducted wherein the students indulged in kite making activities under the theme 'Tribal Festivals'. As the spirit of competition was in full throttle, the first position was bagged by the students of Leaders, the second position by Warriors , and the third position by Challengers.

Our past helps us to learn and move ahead with caution. Learning the same, the students were explained the significance of 'Hiroshima Day' as it aims to promote peace politics against the war. Hiroshima Day serves as a day of remembrance and a focus for anti-war and anti-nuclear demonstrations in several countries. The students made a poster to raise awareness about anti-war weapons and spread the message of Universal Brotherhood and World Peace.



In **Economics**, an activity was conducted wherein the students explained the 'Law of Variable Proportions' with various examples. In **accountancy**, students did an activity where they understood how to charge depreciation on assets. In **General Studies**, two activities were conducted wherein the students made a PowerPoint on the topic "Cyber Safety" and presented it in Grades VI-X and in the second activity, they highlighted the importance of 'Unity in Diversity' through posters.

The 'Investiture Ceremony' signifies the reliance and confidence that the school consigns in the newly invested office bearers. Donning the mantle of accountability, students pledged to bestow their duties to the best of their abilities. Team IHS believes that delegation of responsibility and giving authority to children is important as it teaches them the lifelong skills of being powerful and caring at the same time.
