Greetings!

Another month of the year has ended leaving behind lovely memories. September, a month of transition and transformation, brings with it a mosaic of remaining summer and the onset of the changing season. It is also the month of revision and half yearly examination.

The month of August had academic activities planned that helped extend the teaching learning process and gave the students an opportunity to explore and learn. In Mathematics students did an activity of colouring a picture using the given colour code. This activity was based on divisibility rules and helped the students to retain the rules effectively and easily. While learning about adjectives in Hindi, students drew pictures and described them using different adjectives. In Science an activity based on 3R's (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) was conducted. Through this activity the students learned how to reduce overall scrap output and protect the environment. In English students presented three chapters- Healing the Hills, Awareness About Our Environment and Theseus and the Minotaur through various group activities that included researching, gathering and presenting information, speeches and poems, comic strips, illustrations and timeline. The activity taught the students to work cohesively in groups, time management and presentation skills and most importantly- respect for each other.

Students not only enjoyed 'Heritage Week Activities', but they also got a chance to get connected with the diverse art and culture of India. Through these activities students learnt more about social and cultural values. They enjoyed a ramp walk in tribal dresses, drawing monuments and sharing facts about it that gave them a chance to learn about the art and architecture of India. Our languages help us in keeping ourselves connected to the roots. Keeping this in mind students were given a chance to recite poems in regional languages.

Educational trips as part of the curriculum provide students the joy of discovery and allow them to make new friends, bond with their classmates, and create memories that will stay with them for a lifetime. Students of Grades V- VIII went for an educational trip to Qutub Minar which is one of the most historic landmarks of the Mughal empire, renowned for the artistic brick-work on its pillars and arches. Students were told in detail about the history of the minaret that left them awestruck.

Imperial Heritage School hosted its 3rd Annual Inter School Competition, MAADHYAM, on 12th August 2023 where students from over 25 schools across Gurgaon participated. The theme was Over the Ages- Past, Present and Future, where participants were given an opportunity to recognize this change over the ages and to dwell deeper on the advantages and disadvantages. They got a chance to understand that all objects in the world are subject to change; however, the ideals, virtues and values established in human hearts remain as a perennial source of inspiration to the world. The students showcased their exceptional skills and talents across a range of competitions, leaving an indelible mark on the event.
