Greetings !

Goodbye August, welcome September! It is the month to witness new experiences and enjoy the companionship of good friends. It is the time when the summer heat starts to cool down and the festive season is round the corner.

On the academic front, students were introduced to cursive letters - h, x, k, r, s and f. Practicing writing helps train the brain to integrate various forms of information at once, including visual and tactile inputs, while applying fine motor skills. Students could recap associated sounds and different things connected with the letters. In Numeracy, students were introduced to Sorting and Grouping, Time using o'clock concept, numbers 71 -90, What comes After, Before, In Between and Missing numbers (1-90). The shape- Triangle was also introduced.

The theme in EVS was Plants where students participated in circle time discussions of different food items that they were aware of. It was easy for them to recall junk food and healthy food and everyone was aware that junk food was not good for health. Another discussion was based on what plants give us. Students tried to recollect prior knowledge on the different products that one gets from plants. They were explained the process of germination and also the different elements required for a plant to grow. The students did a germination activity to understand the necessary elements in a more detailed way.

In continuation with the theme, KG presented their first Theme Assembly on the topic- FOOD- where they showcased all their learning of the theme to their parents through a song, dance, information and board reading, both in Hindi and English. The assembly was very informative and the students were very proud to stand in front of their parents and impart their knowledge.

Each month has numerous special days that we celebrate with children, and are often used as learning tools as well. No matter how old we grow, no matter how much distance we have between each other, the bond of friendship is special. To celebrate this beautiful bond, students celebrated Friendship Day where they made a beautiful friendship band and tied it on the wrists of their friend.

Colour Burst for the month was the Tricolour. Colours highlight various emotions and feelings for each individual and to understand the importance of the tri colour for every Indian, the students made a very ingenious white dove and highlighted it with 3D tulip flowers.

Celebrating the feeling of patriotism, Heritage Week was celebrated in school where the students of Kindergarten participated in a variety of activities to help

them develop the feeling of pride for their Motherland. Making a 3D peacock using paper folding, a quiz on Indian national symbols and Intra Class Competitions on dance of any Indian state and Show and Tell on Indian leaders were the activities that kept the students engaged through the week of celebrations.

World Photo Day was celebrated where students made artistic photo frames with pictures of their family and proudly carried it back home.

Imperial Heritage School hosted its 3rd Annual Inter School Competition, MAADHYAM, on 12th August 2023 where students from over 25 schools across Gurgaon participated.
